1. Cut out the deer and fold in half along the dotted line on her back.
2. Using the back edge of a craft knife and a steel ruler, score the two crease lines on her neck and the ones on her tail
3. Fold her neck along both scored lines. Run your fingernails along the lines to crease firmly.
4. Open her out flat and push her head down and in between her front hooves at line A.
5. Fold her head back out from between her hooves at line B.
6. Flip up her tail and fold her antlers out slightly. Fold back in half and christen her.
