From Friday the 25th to Sunday the 27th they will be running a variety of classes each day. Get yourself festival fashion-ready with a feather and flower headdress. Decorate your tent with glorious garlands and build a paper boat or two and take part in the inaugural Port Eliot Twilight Candlelit Regatta. Ros will be teaching beginners crochet and if it all gets too much come to the craft chill out session on Sunday morning!



GLORIOUS GARLANDS, SOAR AWAY STREAMERS AND BIG OL' BUNTING

Learn how to make garlands and bunting to festoon your tent, yurt or camper van. Ros and Christine will show you how to make non stitched triangular bunting as well as paper garlands, streamers made from silk scarves, and a whole lot more. **11am-12pm Friday**

FABULOUS FESTIVAL HEADDRESSES

Be queen of the festival and make your own headdress. From simple paper crowns to gloriously over the top confections Christine & Ros will show you how to make feathers and flowers from paper or fabric. They'll help you create the headdress and personalise them using ribbons, pom poms and glitter **2-3pm Friday, 11.30-12.30pm Saturday**



PAPER BOATS AND A TWILIGHT REGATTA

Hoist the mainsail and ahoy there me hearties! Join Christine and Ros as they build their very own paper boat flotilla. Folded paper, a wooden skewer and a bit of imagination is all you need to make a beautifully seaworthy mini galleon. From tiny tugs to grand ocean liners these paper boats are quick to make and there's a huge variety of papers to inspire you.



Come and watch the launch of the Port Eliot flotilla from the boathouse on the estuary at 7pm. Each paper galleon will sail out towards the viaduct with a tea light to guide it. **5.30-6.30pm Friday**

POM-TIDDILLY-OM-POM-POMS

Pom poms are not just for bobble hats. Learn how to make multi-coloured woolly ones the traditional way with card, mini ones using a fork! (Yes an actual fork) and be inspired by Ros & Christine's method for creating silk ones from shredded scarves. Pom Poms can be added to your headdresses, made into a corsage or used to jazz up almost anything. They'll also be showing you how to make giant tissue paper ones. **10-11am Saturday**

FANTASTIC FELT AND FABRIC FLOWERS

Christine and Ros will teach you how to make felt and fabric flowers. These can be used in a myriad of ways, from hair clips to necklaces, cardi corsages, garlands and bouquets. **1.30-2.30pm Saturday**



BEGINNERS CROCHET

Learn the basics of how to crochet with Ros. She will show you how to make a foundation chain on which all crochet patterns are formed and will show you one or two stitches to start your addiction. If you already know the basics come along anyway and learn how to make a granny square & how to crochet a circle. **3-4pm Saturday**

PERFECT PAPER PINWHEELS

Christine shows you a quick and simple way of making a real wow factor display of paper pinwheels. Ideal if you are looking for a fabulous backdrop for a special event or just to jazz up a plain bedroom wall. These pinwheels are easy to make and also easy to transport so come along and make a few to keep the festival spirit going a little longer once back home.

THE SUNDAY MORNING CRAFT CHILL OUT SESSION

Come down to The Badger's Sett for a morning of chilled out crafting. Try making a headdress, garlands or pom poms, or maybe learn a new crochet stitch. 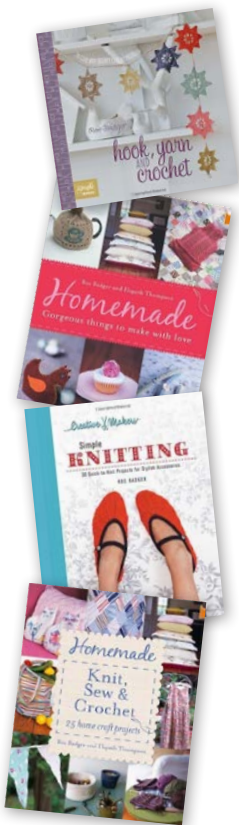
